PURPOSE

This program of instruction provides a Marine with basic knowledge and skills required to interact with a member of a Foreign Security Force (FSF) as part of a Security Cooperation (SC) mission. The target audience for the Marine Advisor Course is private and above serving in a SC capacity.

SCOPE

The three-day Basic Engagement Skills provides fundamental engagement skills training to prepare Marines for overseas Security Cooperation missions. Through formal instruction practical application, students learn to build and maintain relationships and rapport with FSF counterparts, understand nonverbal communication, learn to recognize and mitigate cultural stress, and learn how to employ interpreters. Students graduate prepared to interact with a Foreign Security Force in order to develop its organizational capability and capacity in accordance with US Government, Service, and FSF objectives.

SECURITY CLEARANCE

SECRET CLEARANCE IS MANDATORY!!

Students are required to have a valid Secret Clearance. Security clearance verification must be done for all participants who require access to classified spaces, materials or briefs. The primary means for transmitting the visit request is via Joint Personnel Adjudication System (JPAS). The SMO Code 200031FN5.

Security clearance verification must contain the following information: Full name; rank, grade, or rate; date and place of birth; social security number; citizenship of proposed student; name and address of the activity to be visited; date and duration of the proposed visit; security clearance of proposed visitor, investigation type, date of investigation; and phone number and verifying signature of the Security Manager (if Faxed).
